INSTRUCTIONS

- **1.** Start by mixing # 14 with # 93. (50/50)
- 2. Paint the background with two coats of this gray-green color.
- 3. Mix a small amount of decorative white sand into white paint #67.
- **4.** Using this sand mixture and a small round brush, paint a thin line across the plate, slightly off center.
- **5.** Paint long and evenly spaced brush strokes from this line to the rims on both sides, to resemble a leaf of a tropical tree. Paint slowly and reload the brush with white sand mixture as needed.
- **6.** Before the sand dries, use a sgraffito tool to make deep grooves in the sand. Do this close to one side of each section of the leaf the lower side.
- **7.** Use a Liner brush and # 59 to add shadows. Run the shadow line through the sand groove on the center stem, and then add shadows just below the leaves.
