LEMON WEDGE PLATE

Create this juicy summer platter.



MATERIALS

- Rainbow Plate Pencil
 - #6 Fan Brush
 - #6 Round Brush
 - #2 Round Brush
 - #4 liner brush
- White French Dimensions or Writer Bottle

CMM Colors: 46 - Sunny Side Up, 25 - Safari, 67 - Snow Flake

TIPS

- Before you begin, wipe a damp sponge over entire bisque to remove dust and contaminants.
- To use writer bottles, remove lid and tip. Using a skewer or thin stick, stir the paint well. If needed, add a tiny amount of water and stir well. Replace tip and test on paper for desired flow.

THEME Summer, Lemonade Stand
TAGS Lemon, Lemonade, Plate, Ceramic

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Lightly with pencil sketch sections of lemon leaving approximately an inch for rind around edge of plate and $\frac{1}{4}$ " between sections. Refer to picture.
- 2. Brush each lemon section with 3 coats of Sunny Side Up. Dry well between coats.
- 3. Brush approximately ½ inch around edge of plate (outer lemon rind) with Sunny Side Up also. Dry between the 3 coats.
- 4. Brush 3 coats of Snow Flake in the lemon center, section lines, and inner part of rind. Let dry.
- 5. Pour a small puddle of Safari on palette and using #4 liner brush, paint around each section and make a few irregular lines within each.
- 6. Outline each of the yellow lemon sections with the French Dimensions or writer bottle and add some wavy lines within each to create a "juicy" look. Let dry.
- 7. Brush 3 coats of Sunny Side Up drying well between coats. Let dry completely.
- 8. Leave your plate with your local Color Me Mine studio to be clear glazed and fired. Your ceramic masterpiece will be water and food safe.
