

KAWAII CAULDRON BOWL



MATERIALS

CCX3159 Kitchen Bowl
Detail Brush
Fan Brush
Medium Brush
Character Patterns
NCR Paper or Tissue Paper

COLORS

CMM 2 - Stonewashed
CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 31 - Licorice
CMM 92 - Ghostly Grape
CMM 69 - Carrot Juice
CMM 12 - Mocha Java
CMM 70 - Star Dust



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Start by painting the outside of the bowl with 3 coats of Ghostly Grape using a fan brush.
- 2. While the outside is drying, you can paint the inside and the top rim with 3 coats of Carrot Juice.
- 3. Once the purple is dry, paint the handles of the bowl with 3 coats of Stonewashed using a medium brush.
- 4. Allow everything to dry before tracing on your character patterns.
- 5. Fill in your Ghosts and Skulls using a detail brush and 3 coats of Snowflake.
- 6. Use your detail brush again to fill in the pumpkins with 3 coats of Carrot Juice.
- 7. Then, use your detail brush with Mocha Java to add one heavy coat for the stem.
- 8. To fill in the bats, use your detail brush and 3 coats of Star Dust.
- 9. Then, fill in the spider body with 3 coats of Licorice.
- 10. Finally, add the faces and details to the characters, such as the legs and string for the spiders, and the detail on the bat wings.

TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you nice solid colors.
- Don't be to stressed about the characters being perfect, we are going for cute and quirky
- The hard your push down on the brush, the thicker the line will be. So, on the details keep the brush straight and don't press down to get the finest lines.
